

Besançon

Besançon is a town situated in the Doubs departement (Franche-Comté region) The town of de Besançon is the capital of the region which includes the cantons of de Besançon-Nord-Est, Besançon-Sud, Besançon-Est, Besançon-Ouest, Besançon-Nord-Ouest, Besançon-Planoise. The inhabitants of de Besançon are called Bisontins and their number in the 1999 population census was 117733. The town's surface is 65.2 km². Besançon has the following INSEE code: 25056 and is associated with the following postal code : 25000. It is situated at an altitude of about 261 meters.

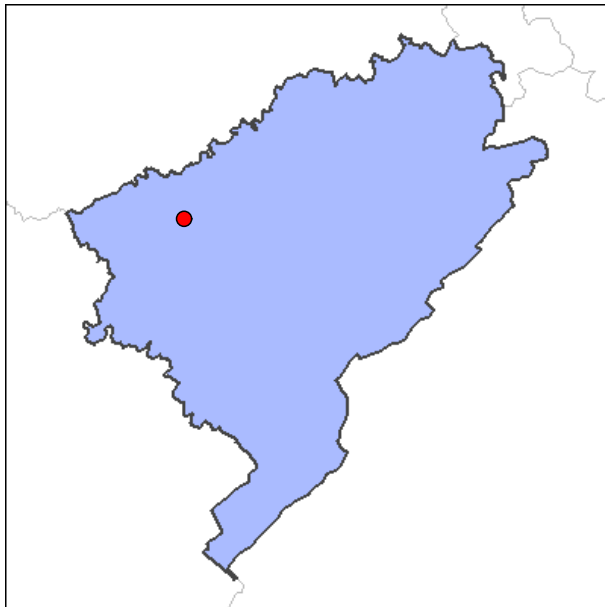
