

Cléder

Cléder is a town situated in the Finistère departement (Bretagne region) The town of de Cléder belongs to the canton of de Plouzévédé and the district of de Morlaix. The inhabitants of de Cléder are called Clédérois and their number in the 1999 population census was 3641. The town's surface is 37.7 km². Cléder has the following INSEE code: 29030 and is associated with the following postal code : 29233. It is situated at an altitude of about 40 meters.

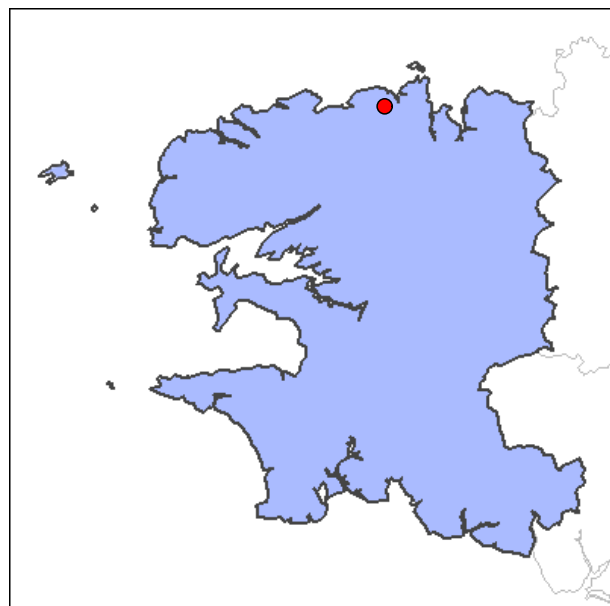
